

COACH CURT JENSON

Head Basketball Coach, Curt Jenson, graduated from Jordan High School in 1953 after achieving All-State honors in basketball and baseball. While attending the University of Utah he was named All-Conference and All-District in both basketball and baseball. In 1957 he played in the annual East-West Basketball Game in Kansas City.

After graduating from the University of Utah he signed a professional baseball contract with the Boston Red Sox Organization. He played five seasons of professional baseball with 3½ seasons in the Triple-A-Classification.

Curt served as assistant basketball coach at the University of Utah under Coach Jack Gardner and Coach Morris Buckwalter in 1960-61 and held a similar post for Coach Ladell Anderson at Utah State University in 1962-63 before coming to CEU in 1964. Jenson-coached teams at CEU have won the ICAC Conference title, The Region One Championship and finished Third in the National JUCO Tournament. They have also placed Third in the Region Playoffs four times and won several preseason tournaments. The Eagles have won 308 games in the past 18 years.






BRAD BOYLE 6'6"

Brad was an All-Stater at East High for Coach Dick Milne in 1979. He averaged 16 points and 8 rebounds per game in helping his team to a 22-4 record and Second place finish in the state tournament. He then played one season at Dixie College, after which he attended the University of Utah before transferring to CEU this year. Brad is a very strong inside player with good skills and should be one of the Eagles' top players.




CRAIG ENSIGN 6'8"

Craig played at Jordan High School for Coach Hal Hale where he led his team to a fourth-place finish in the State Basketball Tournament in 1979. He was second high scorer in the 3-A tournament. He averaged 16 points and 10 rebounds per game and was named All-District, All-Region, and All-State. Craig is returning from an LDS Mission after playing the 1979-80 season for the Eagles. He was a semi-starter and reserve center and averaged 5.4 points and 4.0 rebounds per game. Craig has looked good in practice and should make a big contribution to the Eagles' success this year.




DEREK GEORGE 6'8"

Derek helped lead Bonneville High School to the State 4-A Consolation championship last year under Coach Gary Alverson. He averaged 14 points and 7 rebounds as his team finished with a 20-4 record. He received All-Region and All-State honors and was picked on two All-Star teams. Derek is making good progress and with continued improvement could see a lot of action at center as the season progresses.



TED GUINN 6'2"


Ted played his High School basketball at Ferndale High School in Ferndale, Michigan where he averaged 17 points, 9 rebounds and 5 assists. He was All-League and All-Metro as well as being named All-State Honorable Mention. Last season Ted led the Eagles in scoring and rebounding with 17.3 points and 9.0 rebounds a game, though he missed 10 games with a broken wrist. He was chosen 2nd Team All-Conference and will again be one of the Eagles' leading players.



RAND HENDRICKS 6'6"


Rand played for Coach Ken Thompson at Skyview High School where he averaged 14 points and 8 rebounds a game, and helped his team to the state tournament. Rand transferred to CEU from Navajo Community College last season and was a starter at forward part of the year. He averaged 5.6 points and 4.0 rebounds a game and should give the Eagles needed experience at the front line positions.

DWAYNE HOLSTON 6'2"

Dwayne Holston comes from Ferndale, High School in Michigan where he played for Coach DeWayne Jones. He averaged 13 points and 4 assists playing as a guard-forward. "Magic" is a good shooter and has the quickness and ball handling ability to do a good job for the Eagles as a guard.




JEFF HUDSON 6'3"


TIM LUNT 6'2"

DANNY McENTIRE 6'2"



DUNCAN MILES 6'6"




BARRY NEBEKER 6'1½"

Barry had an outstanding year for Coach Evan Excell at Ben Lomond High School. He was named All-State, All-Region and averaged 18.7 points and 3 assists in leading his team to a 14-13 record and a spot in the State 3-A tournament. Barry, who is also an outstanding student, is a fine shooter and a sound fundamental player who should see considerable action at the guard position.




DUANE NEWSOME 5'10"

Duane attended North High School in Omaha, Nebraska where he averaged 14 points and 7 assists per game for Coach Bob Murray. He was named to the All-Star Metro Team and Honorable Mention All-Metro in the Omaha area. Duane helped his high school team to a third place finish in the District and an overall 14 and 7 record. Last season Duane became eligible in January and played in 9 games, averaging nearly 2 points a game in brief appearances. He has shown much improvement, and his quickness and passing will help the Eagles at the point guard position this season.




LANIER PALMER 6'3"

Lanier played last year for Coach Gary Sophiea at Ferndale High School, the same High School that produced Ted Guinn and Dwayne Holston. Lanier averaged approximately 15 points and 6 rebounds while earning All-League, All-Metro and All-State honors in a 20-3 season. He is a fine jumper and has good quickness and is competing for one of the forward positions.



ROBERT POTTS 6'1"

Bobby played basketball and football and was an outstanding track performer at Carbon High School. After returning from an LDS Mission he made the CEU basketball team last year, and did a good job in a reserve role at the guard position. He averaged 2.4 points a game last year and had some clutch performances for the Eagles. He has looked good in early workouts and should see action again at the guard spot.



GLENN SENINGER 6'4"

Glenn is another East High product. He scored 11.9 points and had 9 rebounds and 6 assists for Coach Ed Palubinskas at East last season as a senior. He was All-Region, Team Captain and received the "Mr. Hustle" award. Glenn has been hampered by a sprained ankle, but should be one of the top competitors for the guard position.






