Star(Utah)-Star is a national organization and the state affiliate is Star Utah (Star Trek Association for Revival in Utah). Under Star**Utah there are 3 branches-Star Salt Lake, Star Ogden, and Star Utah Valley (Provo-Orem). Membership are \$3.00, soon to become \$5.00, so get in fast. You receive for a membership, a year's subscription to the monthly 24 page magazine "The Communicator". You also receive an official membership card to STAR and you get a pack of official STAR TREK paper & Access to the STAR library. Meetings are held 2 or 3 times a month. L.A.N.C.E.--(Lance association Negotiating Coming Episodes) was formed for the purpose of reviving Lancelot Link, Secret Chimp on T.V. Somebody better kill it-or smog will get us all!"

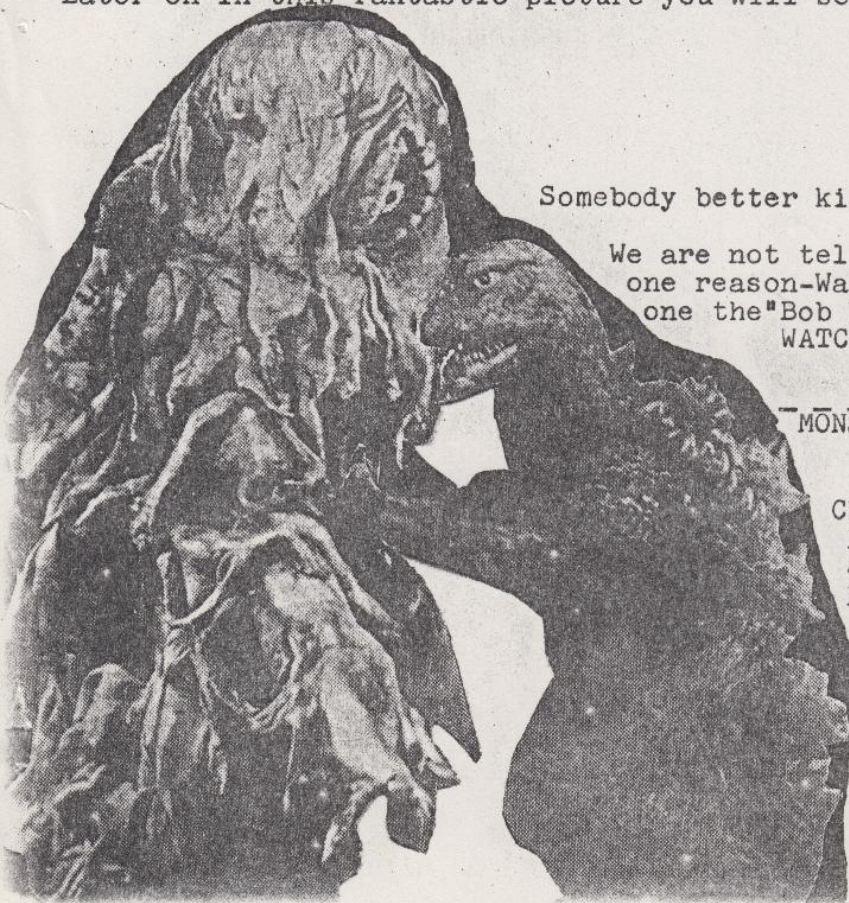
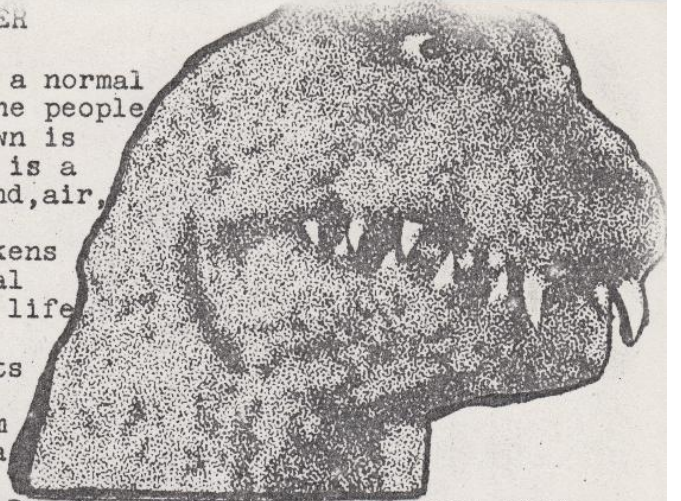

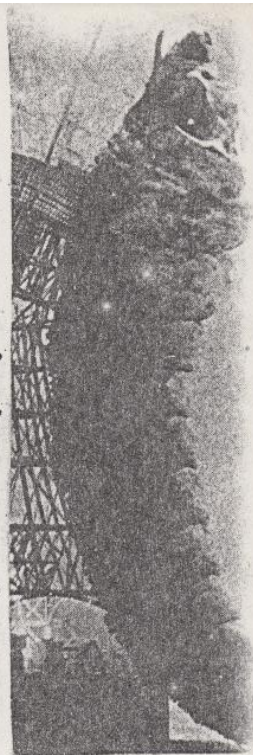
