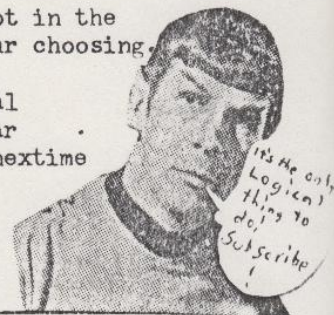

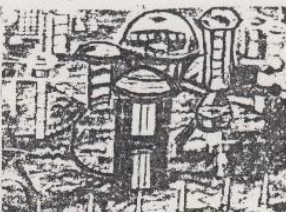

What is the best sci-fi cartoon? Ani-  
mated version of STAR TREK? Well, it isn't  
the best. There is nothing wrong with the  
animated TREK, and the plots are good. But  
the plots of the show here are even better.  
This great show is

### SEALAB:2020

Why is Sealab 2020 so good? Well, for  
one thing, it's realistic. The plots are  
realistic, all based on scientific fact and  
real people. The characters are real, too  
something that isn't usually used in most  
cartoons. The plots could really occur, &  
the city could exist. Unlike some  
undersea sci-fi shows, like Voyage  
to Bottom of Sea, which is unrealis-  
tic, Sealab 2020 is very realis-  
tic. It's alot like Star Trek un-  
derwater, because the producers were  
careful, and made sure that all the  
technology and characters sounded



realistic enough to be true.. The fact that  
it was realistic made it good, but it also  
had good adventure plots. It is a good show  
whether you like sci-fi, adventure, people,  
etc. The show is also designed to teach ec-  
ology and science, which it does very well.

In one episode, an earthquake opened up  
barrels of radioactivity. The Sealab people  
learned not to dump wastes into the ocean, as  
it was dangerous to life. This episode had  
a sub-plot too, as the head of Sealab's son  
was trapped out in radioactive waters, & it  
caused him to be troubled, just like a real  
person. Another episode dealt with drilling  
oil on the Seamount. A scientist in  
Sealab, Ed, protested it, and gave  
up his career to save the ecology of  
Sealab. That story is in LLFW, #3.  
(plug, plug) Buy it to read more of  
the interesting people of Sealab.
