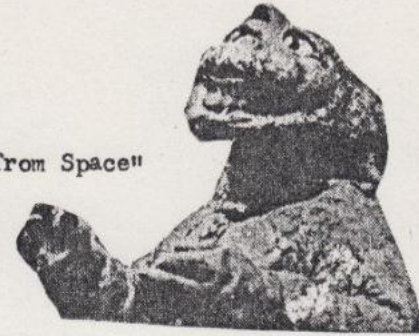

Hello again Trekkies!

We've got good news this week with a report on a Star Trek movie coming up.

Its official now, the U.S.S. Enterprise will take off and fly once again in all corners of Intergalactic space. At last report Roddenberry is now formulating the plot for the show which apparently will have many changes from the original Star Trek. One of the many will be in the Enterprise itself, which will be updated to measure up to new aero-space designs. "What do you mean Remote Control?" asks Tatsuo.

Tatsuo is lead to a remote section of the base, where several silver-clad woman appear. They tell him that they are the Kilaaks, from one of the small planets between Mars & Jupiter. They are controlling the monsters, and several humans, including Dr. Otani. In his panic, Tatsuo pulls a gun on the Kilaaks... but his bullets have no effect. Suddenly, the yellow gas starts to fill the chamber. At this, Tatsuo makes his escape with Dr. Otani. After making his escape, Tatsuo takes Dr. Otani to a UN panel for questioning. Instead of answering, Dr. Otani leaps out the window to his death.

Several transmitters used by the Kilaaks to control the monsters are found all over the world, but before the aliens can be found, Godzilla attacks once again- this time his target is Tokyo. Before long he is joined by Manda, Mothra, and Rodan. Rockets are shot off to try to stop the monsters, but does no good. Buildings are toppled & casualties run high. After the terror has subsided, Tatsuo discusses the matter with an army general.

"The Kilaak enemy is currently setting up in Ebisu" the general says.

"Ebisu" questions Tatsuo?

"There are hot springs there," the general explains. "there all dried up. Monster Land dried up too, remember?"

"Do you think there's a connection between the two?" asks Tatsuo

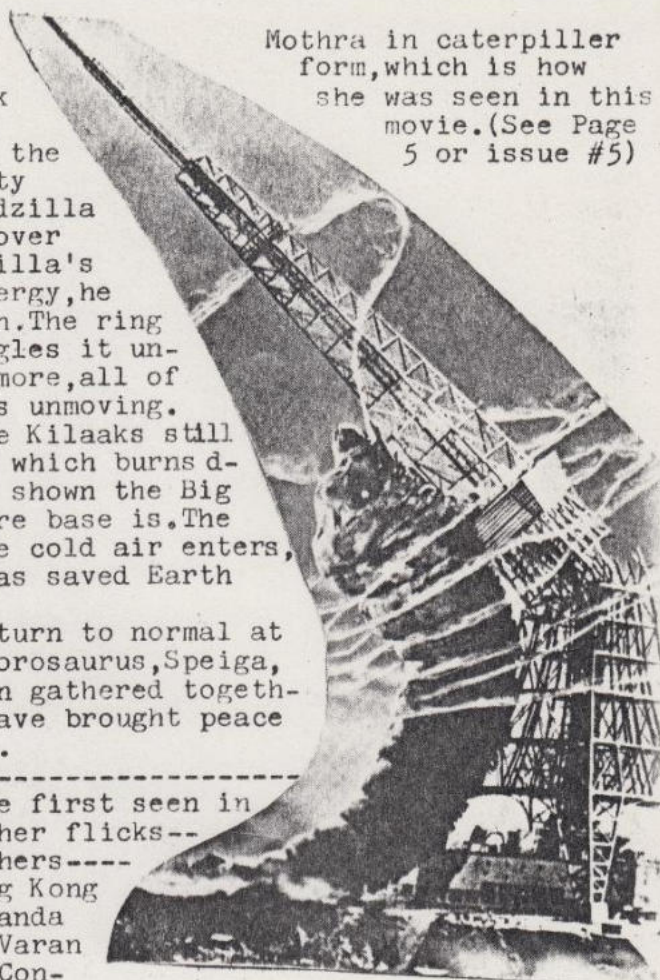

Godzilla and Gorosaurus rush to the 3-headed monster, releasing deadly radioactive rays at it. Mothra tries to spin a silk cocoon around Ghidrah, but Ghidrah escapes. Then Rodan attacks from the air, pecking at the three-headed monster's back...and the mighty Ghidrah starts to weaken. Gorosaurus and Godzilla each take a head of Ghidrah, and work them over with their giant fists. Now even Minya, Godzilla's son gets into the act. Gathering all his energy, he shoots one of his electric rings at Ghidrah. The ring encircles one of Ghidrah's heads and strangles it until it doesn't move. With Ghidrah weakening more, all of Earth's monsters gang up until Ghidrah lies unmoving.

Even with the defeat of their monster, the Kilaaks still don't give up. They launch a giant fire ball which burns down a building. But, by doing that, they have shown the Big G (Godzilla for you know-nothings) where there base is. The Big G rushes over and kicks it in. When the cold air enters, the Kilaaks turn to tiny spores. Godzilla has saved Earth from destruction.

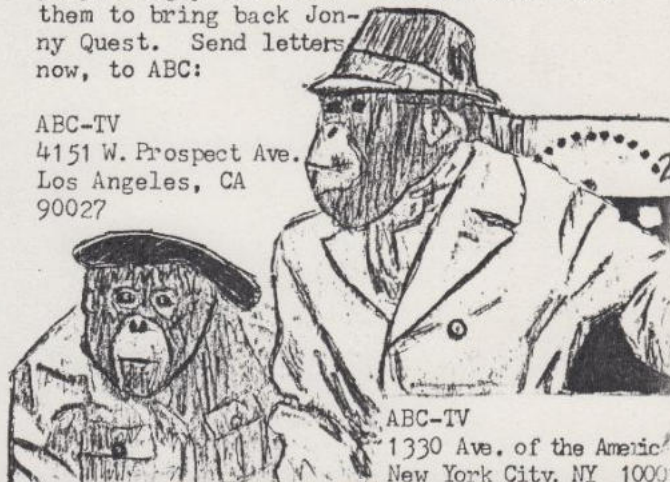

These cards, which first appeared in the early 60's, have been reprinted and revised. Each card features a monster of some sort with a joke underneath it on the front with a "You'll die laughing" joke on the back. The jokes on the front are usually quite funny, but the "You'll die laughing" are rotten. Example:

1st Monster: "This is the 5th time I've caught you sleeping on the job. What do you have to say for yourself?"

2nd Monster: "I'm sure glad today is Friday."
